

Cloud Sentences

Teacher's Guide

It's time to let your students' imagination run wild with this fun adverbs writing activity. Head outside and enter the magical world of clouds as the children watch them come to life and see what hidden images they can spot. They will then write some adverbs to describe what they can see.

Your class will draw a picture of a cloud that looks like something, for example a whale. They will then think of some adverbs that could be used to describe how the whale moves or sounds, e.g. 'powerfully'.

After that the children will create a simple, complex, or compound (depending on differentiation) sentence about the whale. E.g. 'The huge whale swam powerfully through the ocean.'.

This activity is great for a fun starter before getting the children to write their own stories.
