





TEACHER GUIDE

SCIENCE: ANIMALS, CAMOUFLAGE AGES: 4 - 6, 7 - 9, 10 - 12

This Easter themed activity focuses on how animals have adapted to hide themselves in the wild. It looks at the importance of camouflage through a fun and practical activity.

Children will think of an outside location to hide their Easter themed picture before designing and shading the picture to make it as camouflaged as possible. Once they ve finished they can go and hide their Easter themed picture and see if a friend can find their picture.

After the activity it's a great opportunity to talk about the importance of camouflage and see if they can think of any animals that are really well camouflaged in the environment they live in. You could show some videos as examples.


